



5333-35 MAGAZINE, cor. Leontine, bb. Valmont, Camp [Rickerville]. This two-story, Eastlake style double is nearly identical to 5300 Camp at the opposite corner of this square, and to 5221-23 Magazine in the next block. As reported in the *Daily Picayune* of September 1, 1896, John Joseph Hecker had 5333-35 Magazine built for \$2,200 that year. By 1897, according to Soards' *Directory*, Hecker was living there on the downtown side.

Both sides of the structure have second level galleries, and both lower and upper front gallery partitions have been retained.
